

5) Upcoming World Culture and Food Event



On Thursday, March 07, 2024, we will be *(tentatively – based on interest voiced on the this survey)* holding a World Culture and Food Celebration Day in the Island ConnectEd gym. This is an optional event that is a "you must be a participant to participate" activity. The event will be about an hour in duration and will run around lunch time with extra-time provided for set-up and clean-up. It is a family event so students must be accompanied by an adult.

It is a pot-luck style cultural celebration where students/families choose a culture explore/share/celebrate (either their own or one of interest to them). Students are encouraged to discover some facts about a country -- flag, location in the world, clothing, crafts -- and to share those facts and other cultural items at a table. And some may argue, even more important than the facts ... As a family, you create snack-sized food (either small treats or a big treat that can be cut into smaller pieces that are shared with other participants. Each family gets a table to display their artifacts and food. [For K-7 students, this activity can count towards your ADST activities.]

The end goal is to have a fun time together where we share culture and food! During the event, families get a chance to wander around to different tables to learn more about different cultures and to enjoy a taste of different cultures.

Be sure to bring a plastic plate and forks, and something to drink.
